**Swiss Days events kick off on Thursday evening, September 21, at Town Hall with the Community Dinner and Entertainment beginning at 5:00 pm and Opening Ceremony at 6:30 pm. Dinner tickets can be purchased in advance at the city office or at the dinner. Dinner includes your choice of a hamburger or hotdog, baked beans, salad, chips, and dessert. 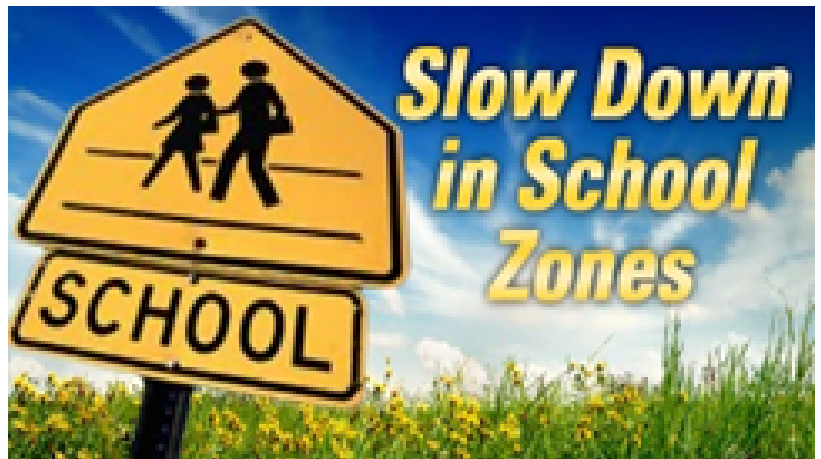


## SEPTEMBER CLEAN-UP DUMPSTERS:

will be available September 8 and 9, 2023 for quarterly residential clean up. There will be 3 dumpsters at Little League Parking Lot and 1 at the Town Hall west side parking lot. Please do not leave trash on the ground before the dumpsters arrive or after they are full or have been removed. If you have large items that need disposed of, such as furniture and appliances, please call Republic Services to schedule a special bulky item pickup; their # is 628-2821. Please remember the dumpsters are not for disposal of hazardous waste materials, chemicals, pesticides, paint, batteries, tires, or construction site waste. For more information regarding hazardous waste materials please call 674-7623. Yellow recycle binnies are available at the Gubler Park to help with disposal of recyclables. Also, the St. George Reuse Center, located at 575 E. Brigham Rd, accepts removed vegetation for mulching- 435-627-4028.
