Spring is finally here after a seemingly endless winter and things are jumping all over the City. The City has issued 193 new building permits since July 1, 2023. This includes 25 single family homes, 39 townhomes, 28 solar permits, 16 pools, with many other accessory buildings, home remodels and additions, awnings and patios. In addition, several new commercial businesses have opened near the Harmons Commercial Center including Alfredo A's Restaurant, Jersey Mike's Sandwich Shop and the Thrive Drip Spa. Orange Peel is getting ready to open on Santa Clara Drive at Country Lane. I'm excited about the new businesses opening in the area to better serve residents closer to home and generate more local sales tax providing important funds to help with Public Safety and Park Improvements.

How long should I water?

Grass and plants have different watering needs.



Sprinklers
Cycle & Soak

- 3 cycles per watering day
- 1 hour between each cycle
- 5 minutes for a fixed spray or 10 minutes for a rotating spray head



Drip Irrigation
Low & Slow

- 1 cycle per watering day
- 20-40 minutes for high-flow emitters or 30-90 minutes for low-flow emitters

Additional tips

- Monitor your landscape and adjust this schedule if needed
- No watering between 10 a.m. – 8 p.m.
- Avoid grass on slopes or in narrow areas that are difficult to water
- Trim around sprinkler heads
- Adjust sprinkler heads so they don't spray walls, driveways or sidewalks
- Check irrigation system regularly and replace broken or missing parts



Home Energy Assistance Target Program

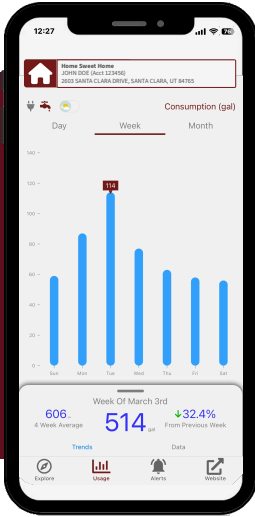

City Clean-Up Dumpsters

Crestview Irrigation Line Construction

Santa Clara City has contracted with Valley Underground to install a secondary irrigation line from Canyon View Drive, near the park, to the Santa Clara Elementary on Crestview Drive. Construction will take place from March 25 - May 30, 2024. Streets will remain open, but please drive cautiously and do not park on the street. This project is included in our Water Master Plan and is important for our community, as it will result in significant savings of 12 million gallons of culinary water annually.
