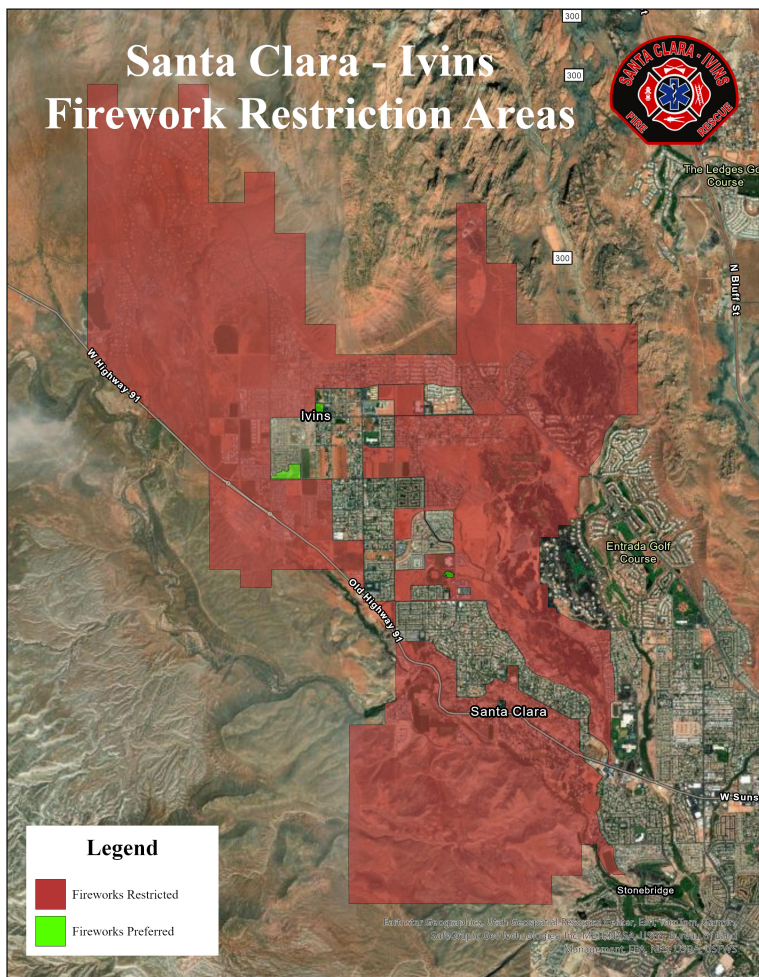

Fireworks Information

Fireworks can be a thrilling part of celebrations, but it's crucial to follow safety guidelines to prevent accidents and injuries. Prohibited activities include the discharge of fireworks in restricted areas and the use of illegal types like firecrackers, cherry bombs, and sky lanterns not approved by the State of Utah. To ensure safety, purchase fireworks only from licensed Utah dealers and use them under responsible adult supervision. Never allow young children to handle fireworks, and always light them in open, non-combustible areas away from flammable materials. Have a bucket of water nearby for emergencies, and never attempt to relight malfunctioning fireworks. After use, soak fireworks in water before disposal and keep pets indoors to protect them from noise and potential harm. To report the discharge of fireworks in restricted areas please call the non-emergency dispatch number at 435-627-4300. For emergencies, call 911. Sales

Commercial fireworks can be sold:

June 24 – July 25

December 29 – December 31

2 days before & on Chinese New Year's Eve

Discharge

Between the hours of 11am & 11pm except as noted:

July 2 – July 5

(July 4 hours extended to midnight)

July 22 – July 25

(July 24 hours extended to midnight)

December 31, 11am – January 1, 1am

Chinese New Year's Eve

January 28, 11am – January 29, 1am

*If New Year's Eve is on a Sunday and the county, municipality or metro township determines to celebrate New Year's Eve on the prior Saturday (December 30), then a person may discharge Class C common State approved explosives on that prior Saturday within the county, municipality, or metro township;

PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ANNEXATION PETITION

Notice is hereby given that Santa Clara City has received a petition proposing the annexation of certain real property into the corporate limits of Santa Clara City. The City Recorder has certified the petition as required by Utah Code §10-2-808. Pursuant to Utah Code §10-2-808, notice is hereby given that Santa Clara City intends to annex the area described in the annexation petition. The proposed annexation area is located at 4405 W 1700 N, Parcel Number 7391 A-1-A and contains approximately 51.24 acres. A complete legal description of the area proposed for annexation is available for inspection at the Santa Clara City Offices, 2603 Santa Clara Drive, Santa Clara, Utah 84765.

Annexation Protest Deadline: Any written protest to the annexation petition must be filed by a property owner within the proposed annexation area or an affected entity with the Washington County Boundary Commission no later than July 18, 2025, and a copy of the protest must also be delivered to the Santa Clara City Recorder at the address listed below.

Public Comment: Citizens and affected entities are encouraged to review the annexation materials and submit written comments to the City Recorder during the publication period. CANCELLATION OF THE MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION

Pursuant to Utah Code § 20A 1 206, Santa Clara City hereby gives notice that the Municipal Primary Election scheduled for Tuesday, August 12, 2025, has been cancelled. The cancellation is due to the fact that the number of candidates who filed for municipal office does not exceed twice the number of open positions for any at-large race, and no qualified write-in candidates have filed. As such, a primary election is not required by state law.

SIZZLING SUMMER WATERING TIPS

Cycle & soak lawns no more than 4X a week.

- 3 cycles per watering day
- 1 hour between each cycle
- 5 minutes per cycle

Run drip systems low & slow 3X a week.

- 1 cycle per watering day
- 20-40 minutes for high-flow emitters
- 30-90 minutes for low-flow emitters

WATER EFFICIENT LANDSCAPE PROGRAM

Ready to convert your grass to a water-efficient landscape?

The Washington County Water Conservancy District will rebate property owners for each square foot of grass removed and replaced with water efficient landscaping.

Rebate amounts

- \$2.00 per square foot up to 5,000 square feet
- \$1.00 per square foot for more than 5,000 square feet
- Minimum of 300 square feet to qualify

After your application is submitted, you must participate in a pre-conversion site visit. Starting your project prior to application approval and a pre-conversion site visit will make your conversion ineligible.

Home Energy Assistance Target Program

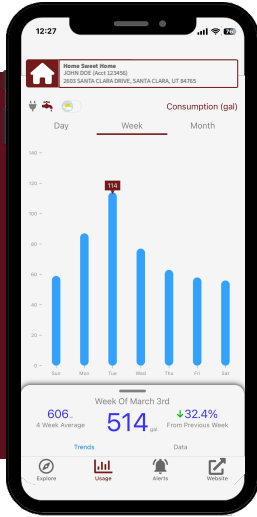
