The Grand Marshals for 2024 are Virgil and Alice Atkin Steel. The Steels are long-time residents of Santa Clara and are the people to thank for our community herd of Swiss Days Cows!

Virgil was raised in Burley, Idaho, while Alice was growing up in St George, Utah. The two met at BYU and were married on March 28, 1970. Virgil earned his degree in Industrial Education and Alice in Home Economics Education. Upon graduation, they moved to Kaysville, Utah and both began teaching in that area. Virgil went on to teach woodshop for 11 years at Layton Jr High while they started their family. In 1980, they decided to move from Kaysville to St George, and in 1986 moved into their home in Santa Clara. The Steels have 6 children: Shaun, Jodi, Wade, Preston, Drew, and Megan; and they have 25 grandchildren!

While living in southern Utah, Virgil began working for Western Woods making display cases for businesses and Alice began teaching preschool. The Steel family also had a small business making dollhouses and doll furniture to sell at the "Santa's Workshop" craft show each year.

Virgil and Alice easily felt at home in Santa Clara, and noticed the community spirit of the residents, and they quickly became involved. Alice has used her talents to help create quilts and seed displays for the City and has volunteered many hours on behalf of the Santa Clara Historical Society.

Virgil is the person responsible for cutting out all the wooden cows displayed during Swiss Days. Once while on a trip with friends to Switzerland, the group of travelers noticed a painted wooden cow. They thought how wonderful these would be in Santa Clara during Swiss Days. Alice took a few pictures of this cow for reference and when they returned home they came up with the design for the wooden cows that have been used for Swiss Days ever since. Other than a few years that they were gone serving LDS missions, Virgil has used a jigsaw to cut every cow that you have seen displayed for Swiss Days for the last 18 years. He just "retired" from this task last year!

When asked what they love about Santa Clara, the Steels mentioned the scenery, great weather, and sycamore trees, but at the top of their list were the incredible people of Santa Clara. They both feel so grateful to have moved to this wonderful city where they are surrounded by great neighbors and friends!

SANTA CLARA BLACK DESERT PGA TOUR CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

Event Dates & Schedule

The Black Desert PGA Tour Championship will be held from October 9-13, 2024, with the course open to ticket holders. On October 7-8, there will be a Pro-Amateur tournament and practice rounds, which will be closed to the public. Daily event hours will be approximately 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM.

Traffic & Transportation

There will be no road closures for the entirety of the event and Pioneer Parkway will continue to function well during the event. There will be two main entrances: one on Snow Canyon Parkway and another on Pioneer Parkway. No public parking will be available on site. Offsite parking with shuttles will be the primary mode of transportation for ticket holder attendees. Heavy congestion can be expected along Bluff Street, Pioneer Parkway, and Snow Canyon Parkway, particularly in the late afternoon to early evening.

Attendance & Security

Black Desert is anticipating several thousands of attendees per day at the event. The resort and any amenities will be closed to the public during the duration of the event (October 7th – 13th, 2024). Officers from the Santa Clara-Ivins and St. George Police Departments, as well as the Utah Highway Patrol, will assist with traffic control along Pioneer Parkway and Snow Canyon Parkway.
