# BLACK DESERT PGA TOUR CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

## **Event Dates & Schedule**

The Black Desert PGA Tour Championship will be held from October 9-13, 2024, with the course open to ticket holders. On October 7-8, there will be a Pro-Amateur tournament and practice rounds, which will be closed to the public. Daily event hours will be approximately 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM.

## **Traffic & Transportation**

There will be no road closures for the entirety of the event and Pioneer Parkway will continue to function well during the event. There will be two main entrances: one on Snow Canyon Parkway and another on Pioneer Parkway. No public parking will be available on site. Offsite parking with shuttles will be the primary mode of transportation for ticket holder attendees. Heavy congestion can be expected along Bluff Street, Pioneer Parkway, and Snow Canyon Parkway, particularly in the late afternoon to early evening.

## **Attendance & Security**

Black Desert is anticipating several thousands of attendees per day at the event. The resort and any amenities will be closed to the public during the duration of the event (October 7th – 13th, 2024). Officers from the Santa Clara-Ivins and St. George Police Departments, as well as the Utah Highway Patrol, will assist with traffic control along Pioneer Parkway and Snow Canyon Parkway.

# October is **Domestic Violence** Awareness Month

Susan Ertel, board president of the Dove Center, recently encouraged the Santa Clara City Council to proclaim October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month. This proclamation took place during the City Council meeting on September 25th.

Following Mayor Rick Rosenberg's reading and signing of the official proclamation, Ertel highlighted the current challenges faced by the Dove Center Foundation and expressed appreciation to first responders for their ongoing support. Local first responders have been introducing new protocols over the past year to better assist victims of domestic violence.

# WATER EFFICIENT LANDSCAPE PROGRAM

## Ready to convert your grass to a water-efficient landscape?

The Washington County Water Conservancy District will rebate property owners for each square foot of grass removed and replaced with water efficient landscaping.

### Rebate amounts

- \$2.00 per square foot up to 5,000 square feet
- \$1.00 per square foot for more than 5,000 square feet
- Minimum of 300 square feet to qualify

After your application is submitted, you must participate in a pre-conversion site visit. Starting your project prior to application approval and a pre-conversion site visit will make your conversion ineligible.

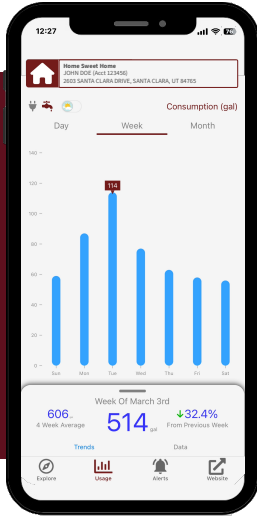
