## WATER EFFICIENT LANDSCAPE PROGRAM

## Ready to convert your grass to a water-efficient landscape?

The Washington County Water Conservancy District will rebate property owners for each square foot of grass removed and replaced with water efficient landscaping.

#### Rebate amounts

- \$2.00 per square foot up to 5,000 square feet
- \$1.00 per square foot for more than 5,000 square feet
- Minimum of 300 square feet to qualify

After your application is submitted, you must participate in a pre-conversion site visit. Starting your project prior to application approval and a pre-conversion site visit will make your conversion ineligible.

# Cancellation of the 2025 Municipal Primary Election

Pursuant to Utah Code § 20A-1-206, Santa Clara City hereby gives notice that the Municipal Primary Election scheduled for Tuesday, August 12, 2025, has been cancelled. The cancellation is due to the fact that the number of candidates who filed for municipal office does not exceed twice the number of open positions for any at-large race, and no qualified write-in candidates have filed. As such, a primary election is not required by state law.


