



IMPORTANT NOTICE

Street Closure for Asphalt Slurry Seal

Dear Resident:

During the coming week American Pavement Preservation, under contract with The City, will be placing an asphalt slurry seal on your street. This notice is being sent out in advance so that you can plan ahead for this work. Please be advised that in order to perform this work, your street will be closed for a few hours, for at least one day. The work will normally be completed between the hours of 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. The slurry seal is wet asphalt when applied and several hours to dry. Please plan for alternate parking and driving for the short term while your street is closed. Alternating streets will be closed for short periods of time so you can use an alternate street to park and drive on. No Parking signs indicating the date of the slurry seal application will be placed on the streets. **Please look for a street without a “No Parking” sign to park on during the time your street is closed.**

THE DAY BEFORE YOUR STREET IS SCHEDULED TO BE CLOSED YOU WILL BE GIVEN AN ADDITIONAL NOTICE AND INFORMATION EXPLAINING THE PROCESS.

Please do not drive in the wet asphalt slurry seal before the street is open to traffic. If you drive on the wet asphalt prior to the street being open to traffic the wet asphalt will get on your vehicle and vehicle tires. Prior to the street closure it will be necessary for you to move parked cars, boats, trailers, dirt, grass piles and other items from the street. Vehicles will not be allowed on the street for a few hours during the street closure. Please keep the street clean and clear of any items until the work has been completed on your street. Your cooperation is appreciated.

American Pavement Preservation under contract with The City will be placing Slurry Seal Asphalt on your street. Your street will be closed on the date listed above from 7am to 6pm, please park your vehicle on a NON-POSTED STREET before 7am so that you will not be deprived of its use. Please note that the slurry seal will be placed on various streets in your neighborhood and various streets will be closed for the application. Barricades will be on the streets that will be closed, please find a street that doesn't have "NO PARKING" signs on to park on for the day.

TRASH: If your trash pick-up day is the same day that your street is scheduled for Slurry Seal your trash will be picked-up before we close your street. Please have your trash out the night before.

**PLEASE DO NOT MOVE THE BARRICADES TO DRIVE OR PARK ON THE STREET
If you drive on your street before the slurry seal has dried and set you WILL DAMAGE your street.**

Please do not permit sprinkler water to spray onto the street or asphalt seal during this time.

UNDER NORMAL WEATHER CONDITIONS, your street should be back in service by 6:00 p.m. Work not done because of rain, wet weather, or circumstances beyond our control will be rescheduled. You will be notified of the new date when your street has been re-scheduled. Due to the number of streets scheduled and various conditions, **we cannot tell you the exact time your street will be done.**

Driving or walking on this new wet asphalt material before it has cured will damage the street; the wet asphalt will stick to your shoes, be splattered upon your car, and will track onto concrete driveways.

Please wait until the street is opened to traffic to drive on it.

Sharp turning during the curing phase will damage the Asphalt Slurry Seal Application specifically power steering turns. Always be sure the vehicle is moving slowly before turning the steering wheel.

The slurry seal is being placed on the existing asphalt surface on your street to protect it from water and the weather damage.
